Our Commitment To Privacy

Your privacy is important to us. The Information We Collect:

The Way We Use Information:

Subscribing to Architecture 2030's E News Bulletin updates requires a separate subscription process via the specific E News Bulletin subscription form.

Architecture 2030 is the sole owner of the information that is collected and maintenance of this information is at the sole discretion of Architecture 2030, who may, at any time and for any reason, close, phase-out or otherwise alter the appearance of its lists.

Being listed on the public website as a supporter or adopter is voluntary and the option to opt-out of being listed publically is provided at the time of sign-up.

Finally, we never use or share the personally identifiable information provided to us online in ways unrelated to the ones described above without also providing you an opportunity to opt-out or otherwise prohibit such unrelated uses. We use return email addresses to answer the email we receive. Such addresses are not used for any other purpose and are not shared with outside parties.
